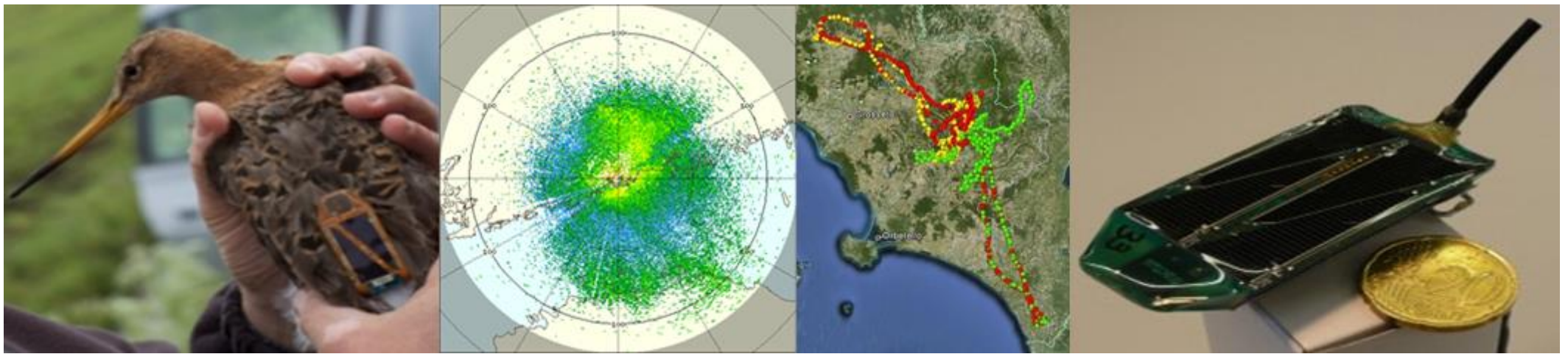

COURSE SCOPE
